



PLAYDATES 2020 – 2021 HEALTH and SAFETY GUIDELINES PROGRAM INTERRUPTION REFUND POLICIES

HEALTH and SAFETY GUIDELINES

- **If your child, you or anyone in your household is sick, please stay home! If your child or a family member is ill with a cold, flu, fever, respiratory or any covid related symptoms, please keep your child home from *Playdates* for 48 hours after their illness and symptoms subside. If your child has been in contact with or diagnosed with the Covid 19 virus, a 14 day quarantine period and a doctor's note is required to return to *Playdates*. Please carefully read additional Covid related safety policies and guidelines provided below.**
- * All Playdates Staff will wear a child-friendly mask.
- * Daily temperature monitoring: At drop off, the Parent or caregiver will take their child's temperature in front of a staff member. MBP will provide non-contact temperature monitors.
- * Any child with a temperature of 100 degrees or above will not be allowed to stay.
- * All children and staff are required to have a current **FLU SHOT**.
- * Following the American Academy of Pediatrics vaccination schedule, all participants are required to be fully up to date with their vaccinations. **EXEMPTIONS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.**
- * Surface areas will be continually sanitized and hands washed thoroughly throughout the morning.
- * Social Distancing: Playdates Staff will do their best to adhere to social distancing of the children during activities. However, given the nature of activities and temperament of 2 - 3 year olds, **Playdates does not guarantee** the enforcement of state guidelines for social distancing.
- * The safety and happiness of the children is our priority. We do anticipate separation anxiety at the drop off. Parents will be called to pick up a child having difficulty settling in to the morning activities.

PLAYDATES INTERRUPTION POLICY

In the event Playdates must close early due to Covid-19 or any unexpected circumstances, tuition refunds will be issued for the remaining session time less a 15% administrative fee.
